WHAT DOES DISCOVERING CHRIST LOOK LIKE?

The Discovering Christ course runs seven evenings plus a day retreat. Each evening session begins with dinner, and then moves on to a short teaching (with a coffee and dessert break) followed by small group discussion.

CAN NON-CATHOLICS OR NON-CHRISTIANS ATTEND THE COURSE?

Yes, the primary aim is to bring all people to encounter with Christ through the foundational proclamation of the Gospel. While the setting is Catholic and the teachers are faithful, committed Catholics - the majority of the teaching is on elements common to all major Christian denominations.
